Lake Ndutu Luxury Tented Lodge Fact Sheet

Location

The lodge is located in Ndutu, in the southeastern plains of the Serengeti ecosystem within the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. The lodge is built on a high ground with views of Lake Ndutu about a kilometre to the southeast.

- GPS Coordinates: -2.9902917, 34.9803078
- 5km (15 minutes drive) from Ndutu airstrip,
- 90km (2 hours drive) from the Ngorongoro Crater
- 80km (1 ½ hours drive) to Seronera in Central Serengeti,
- 150km (3 hours drive) from Lake Manyara National Park
- 50 minutes flight from Arusha town by small aircraft or 5 hours drive (300km).

Altitude: Metres 1,690 above sea level

Climate

The wet season falls between November to May with short rains in November and December and long rains from mid March to May. This is the green season when big herds of wildebeest accompanied by zebras, gazelles can be seen in the area with calving taking place January through March - excellent opportunities for viewing predators including lions, cheetah and hyena in action

The dry season runs from June to October, it is a quiet time of the year with less visitors and almost exclusive game viewing opportunities of resident wildlife.

NB: The lodge is open throughout the year, offering great price reductions between mid April and end of November.

Power & Electricity

The lodge provides 24 hours electricity supplied by eco friendly solar power supported by 2 standby generators and inverters.

The generator is switched on, 6 to 9 in the morning and again 6 to 9 in the evening, for shaving, hair dryers, and charging up electronic devices. Voltage is 220.

Guest Accommodation

The lodge consists of 20 large guest tents (70sqm), including 2 family suites each offering 2 guest tents connected to a shared lounge, all en-suite and nestling under Makuti roofing (palm fronds) for shade and protection against the elements.

A specially converted accommodation tent is available on request for guests with physical disabilities (limited mobility), while the lounge & dining areas are all wheelchair accessible

The tents are elevated a meter from the natural ground, resting on wooden stilts and platforms and set 15 meters from each other for privacy.

The room amenities include:

- En suite bathrooms with two hand-wash basins, a flushing toilet, two showers (outdoor shower with open sky and an indoor shower)
- Double, twin, triple beds with quality linen, mosquito netting and bedside tables.
- Sofa seats with coffee table
- Remote controlled ceiling fan
- Mosquito sprays and wipes
- Writing desk with table lamp and chair
- WiFi internet access
- Dressing table, magnifying glass, bathrobes and hairdryers
- Mini fridge
- Safe deposit box
- Tea & coffee facilities
- Large balcony with safari armchairs and table
- Luggage rack

Public Areas

- Reception with a sitting area and two washrooms
- Lion's Den Lounge and Simba Restaurant separated by a view deck, both with a large open-air terrace,
- A view deck with magnifying equipment
- A souvenir shop
- Internet access
- Campfire area

- Game drives in open 4x4 safari vehicles
- Guided nature walks
